iLED is a two-week curriculum taught by Notre Dame faculty with a focus on international leadership, including courses in the College of Engineering, College of Science, Mendoza College of Business, College of Arts and Letters, and the School of Architecture.

- Strengthen cross-cultural competency and leadership skills
- Solve problems by working in teams and collaborating as leaders with an open-mindset

Important Dates and Deadlines

- December 15, 2018: Online application open for both sessions
- January 31, 2019: Rolling admissions begin for both sessions
- March 24, 2019: Application deadline for both sessions
- June 8, 2019: Session 1 begins and students arrive on campus
- June 22, 2019: Session 1 concludes and students depart from campus
- July 13, 2019: Session 2 begins and students arrive on campus
- July 27, 2019: Session 2 concludes and students depart from campus

Cost

\$4,000 which covers:

- Tuition, on-campus housing, and three meals a day
- All program-sponsored activities
- Medical insurance
- Airport pick-up and drop-off at O'Hare Airport and all transportation during the program

Eligibility

- Currently enrolled in high school
- Minimum 15 years old when attending the program
- Outstanding academic transcript
- High level of English language proficiency: TOEFL IBT 80+ preferred, or IELTS 6+ preferred; other evaluations of English language proficiency considered and interviews may be required
